Richelieu Gestion's reorganisation begins

On 27th November, Laurence Adam was appointed Deputy Chief Executive Officer and Chief Operating Officer of Richelieu Gestion in a first step towards the fund management firm's transformation. This follows Christophe Boulanger's arrival as Chief Executive Officer in July 2018.

Back in July, a new private banking and asset management platform was created bringing together Banque Richelieu France, Banque Richelieu Monaco and Richelieu Gestion, under the aegis of holding company Compagnie Financière Richelieu.

At the same time, **Christophe Boulanger**, appointed **Chief Executive Officer of Richelieu Gestion**, took over as head of the new Group's asset management subsidiary.

He was previously Chief Executive Officer of Edmond de Rothschild Asset Management. Christophe Boulanger has more than 20 years' experience in asset management, beginning his career at Arthur Andersen as an audit manager for the banking sector before joining Edmond de Rothschild Asset Management as Chief Financial Officer.

He has now been joined by **Laurence Adam**, appointed **Deputy Chief Executive Officer and Chief Operating Officer**, as the fund management firm strives to restructure its organisation and turn it into a major growth driver.

Laurence Adam, aged 44, holds a two-year general university diploma in Mathematics Applied to Social Sciences from Paris XII university, a Master's degree in Management Sciences majoring in Finance from ESA Paris XII and a post-graduate degree in Financial Engineering from Ecole Supérieure des Affaires Paris XII. She began her career at BAREP (part of Groupe Société Générale) as a middle office fund manager before helping to create Systeia Capital Management (part of Groupe Crédit Agricole) of which she then became head of the middle office. Prior to joining Richelieu Gestion, she was Head of Operations and an Executive Committee member at Edmond de Rothschild Asset Management France.

Christophe Boulanger comments: "We are delighted to welcome Laurence to Richelieu Gestion. Besides restructuring our product range, we aim to thoroughly overhaul our operating platform and associated range of services. Laurence has a great deal of experience in different areas of asset management and will devote most of her time to this task."
